## **PrEP Side Effects: Know the Facts!**

Don't let concern for side effects stop you from taking PrEP.

Tip for using this sheet: The percentages below are the percentage of people who took each medication during the research studies who reported experiencing side effects. Notice that even the most common side effects are rare.

\*Stomach symptoms go away within two weeks of starting Truvada and Descovy. Taking either medication before bed has been shown to decrease stomach symptoms.
