### Systems of Care Programmatic Updates

#### CalAIM Justice Involvement (JI) Initiative



**Purpose:** California received federal approval to offer targeted Medicaid services for eligible youth and adults in state prisons, county jails, and youth correctional facilities.

- As part of the CalAIM JI, counties are required to implement:
  - Behavioral Health Linkages are mandated by the State to go live on October 1, 2024.
    - Initial demand for Los Angeles County (LAC) CalAIM JII behavior health linkages anticipated to be low.
  - CalAIM JII Pre-release Services for all CA CFs must go live between October 1, 2024, to September 30, 2026.
    - LAC pre-releases services anticipated to go live between 2025-2026.
    - CDCR pre-release services anticipated to go live between 2025-2026.
- Next Steps:
  - SAPC will engage providers to discuss CalAIM JI
  - Release guidance on the behavioral health linkage requirements as we move towards full implementation.



**Purpose:** BRIDGE initiative aims to enhance providers' capacity to deliver family supportive services for caregivers and families of youth, particularly youth with complex needs, juvenile-justice involved youth, and those recently released from detention or secure facilities.

Services to be Provided:

- Early Family Engagement
- Family Education
- Community Outreach and Engagement
- Family Support Groups
- Leadership and Mentoring Programs
- Positive Family Development (PFD) Program
