





TECHNICAL READINESS REVIEWS

What are Technical Readiness Reviews?	Meetings that are primarily advisory in nature and offer opportunities to share challenges and success in navigating the START ODS.
What happens at these meetings?	Introductions and overview followed by more focused discussions on provider status, barriers, suggestions, and clarification on requirements.
Which staff should participate?	Primarily staff responsible for clinical oversight, finance, billing, and intake, but any who would benefit can participate.
Who from SAPC will attend?	Interdisciplinary group representing several SAPC divisions.
When will these take place?	late October to mid January.
How much time will this take?	Readiness Review meetings should be no longer than 2 hours.
How Should I Prepare?	SAPC will contact Providers about 3-6 weeks in advance. Providers will be asked to complete a brief Readiness Review survey as well as CIBHS' <i>"Projecting Service Capacity and Revenue"</i> (webinar and template).
Will this replace the annual monitoring visit?	No. The annual monitoring visits will begin in 2018.
