- Providers may request deferment based on system issues.

### Fiscal Year (FY) 23/24 Contract Amendments:

- SAPC Initiated Augmentations in progress and closing out in November 2023.
- Amendment request can be submitted at **50%** utilization

### DMC Contract Renewals (expire June 30, 2024)

 SAPC will extend existing DMC contracts for 1 year through 6/30/25 and then REPLACE with a CalAIM contract

## **Contracts & Compliance Reminder**

### **Covid-19 and Influenza Vaccination Requirements (IN 23-11)**

Effective November 1, 2023: staff in patient care areas must be fully vaccinated against (1) Influenza <u>and</u> (2) Covid-19 (*2023-24 Formula*)

- ✓ Agencies must provide your signed attestation of compliance back to SAPC immediately (<u>SAPCMonitoring@ph.lacounty.gov</u>)
- Any applicable staff who decline or are not yet vaccinated by November 1, will be required to wear a respiratory mask in patient care areas during the respiratory viral season (Annually November 1 – April 30)
