## SUBJECT: **PROVIDER STAFFING GUIDELINES**

The Department of Public Health, Division of Substance Abuse Prevention and Control (DPH-SAPC) is issuing an updated version of the Provider Staffing Guidelines Information Notice that mandates the specific treatment staffing levels that must be in place to provide and bill for services under the Los Angeles County, Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System (DMC-ODS).

Attached is the Provider Staffing Guidelines Grid, which includes:

- Staffing level/s that can conduct each of the substance use disorder (SUD) Treatment Services
- Quality Improvement and Utilization Management (QI and UM) requirements across all levels of care and benefits
- Billing Codes (HCPCS)
- Appendix
- List of Licensed Practitioners of the Healing Arts (LPHA), including the specific definition for licensed-eligible LPHAs

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- Recommended activities for Medical Directors
- Minimum Qualifications for newly hired and existing Registered SUD Counselors
