



# HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION PROGRAM

#### What is Homelessness Prevention?

Homelessness Prevention provides individuals and families who are at imminent risk of homelessness with:

- Financial assistance and housing stabilization services necessary to maintain their current housing; OR
- Find new housing to avoid becoming homeless and entering the emergency shelter system.

### Who is eligible for the Homelessness Prevention Program?

Homelessness Prevention may be available to persons who meet <u>at least one</u> of the following criteria AND are screened as having a <u>high risk of becoming homeless</u>:

- Experiencing a financial crisis and at imminent risk of becoming homeless
- Have received a court eviction hearing notice or court-ordered eviction
- Have received written notice of intent to terminate tenancy from a landlord (includes 3-day pay or quit)
- Lacks family and financial resources, placing one at risk of becoming homeless

### What are the required Income eligibility guidelines for assistance?

- Must fall below the 50% Area Median Income (AMI)
- Formerly Homeless Section 8 holders with income up to 80% of Area Median Income (AMI)
